Installing E-Z UP® Rail Skirts

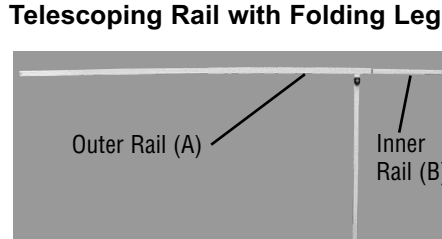


Instructions for installing rail skirts on 8' x 8' or 10' x 10' E-Z UP® Instant Shelters®.
Please see reverse side for installing rail skirts on 10' x 15' and 10' x 20' E-Z UP® Instant Shelters®.

Important: Read instructions from start to finish on both sides before attempting to install rail skirts.

Parts

For installing one rail skirt



Two (2) sliders per rail skirt



Two (2) latch pins per rail skirt

Step One

Place sliders on legs

Set up your E-Z UP® Instant Shelter®. Take a two prong slider and go to one leg of the side where the rail skirt will be attached. If possible, have a partner take a slider to the leg opposite you and simultaneously do step one with you: two people following this step together avoids the chance of twisting the shelter's frame.

First, raise legs to highest height adjustment (snap button in bottom hole).

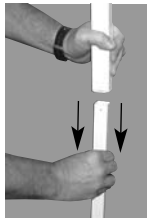
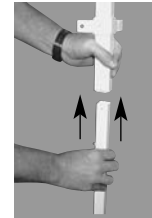

With one hand holding outer leg below the slider, use your other hand to insert inner leg back into outer leg (fig. 3).

Now slide the two prong slider onto the outer leg (fig. 2). Check that the slider's prongs face *into* the shelter.

Snap legs together at hole at bottom of outer leg. The snap button now supports slider (fig. 4).

Step Two

Fit skirt to rail

Hold skirt vertical, sleeve side up. Take telescoping rail and open to "L" shape by swinging down the Folding Leg. Insert Outer Rail (A) through sleeve from center to end (fig. 5).

Now slide Inner Rail (B) from Outer Rail (A), threading Inner Rail through sleeve just as you did the Outer Rail, from center to end.

Inner rail extends until it snaps into place (fig. 6).

Step Three

Secure Rail Skirt to shelter legs with pins and straps

Position the rail skirt across the side of shelter. At each end, the rail fits on side of prong that faces *into* the shelter, so that it fits flush with legs (fig. 7).

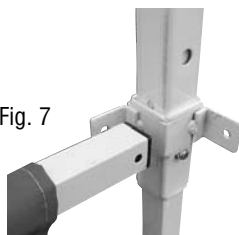
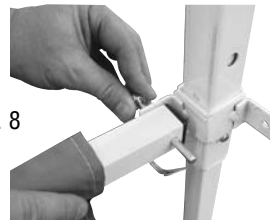

With latch pin open and pointed toward the shelter, insert pin first through prong, then through rail (fig. 8). Latch pins clasp swivels under rail to snap on tip of pin protruding from other side of rail.

Each end of the skirt has three Velcro® straps. Wrap each strap around leg and fasten (fig. 9). Also attach Velcro® strap to rail leg. The rail skirt is now installed.

Take Down

To take down the rail skirt, repeat steps two and three in reverse order. Sliders may be left on legs to save time on future rail skirt installations. To store skirts, telescope the Inner Rail (B) back into the Outer Rail (A) and close Folding Legs. Fold the skirt in half so that both vertical ends are touching. Now, roll the fabric around the telescoping rail.
