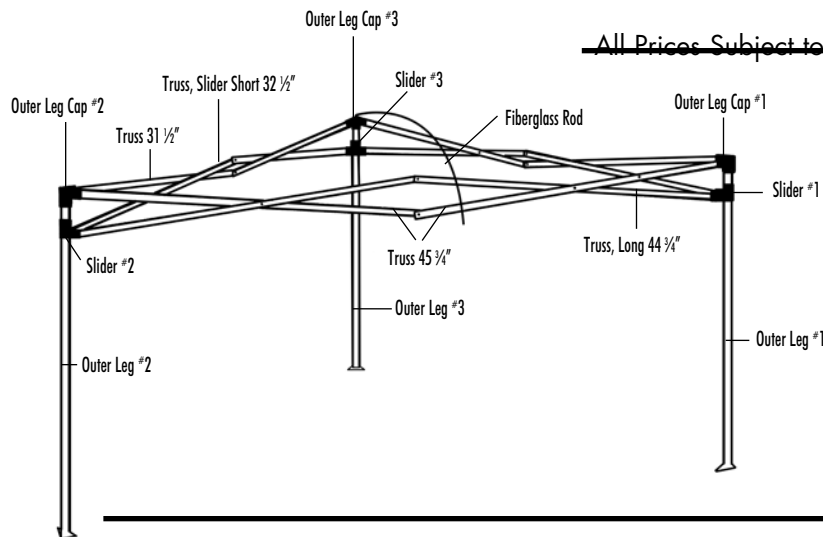

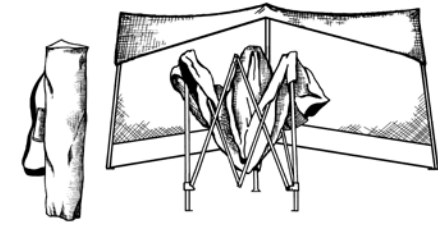

## What's In The Box

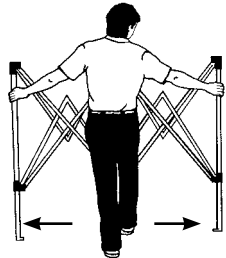
Please read each step before you attempt to set up. Save these instructions for future reference. Return the Warranty Card within 10 days of purchase.

- 1 Wedge™ Frame Fully Assembled
- 1 Carry Bag
- 1 Wedge™ Top
- 3 Piece Stake Kit

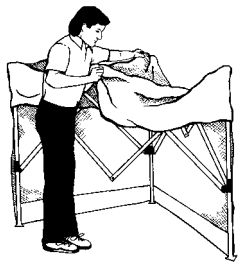
## How To Set Up

### \*Note: First Time Attachment Is Required

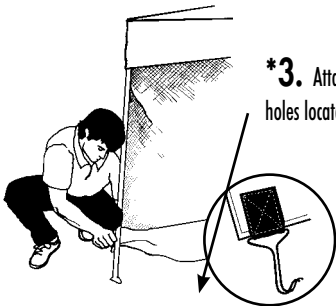
Top and frame are shipped unattached to avoid damage. A first time set up requires that the top be attached to the frame. This first-time set up takes longer than 60 seconds. Once top is permanently attached to frame, set up and take down are easily accomplished within 60 seconds.



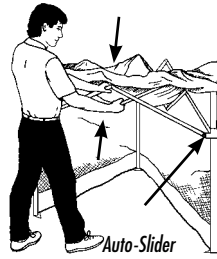
**1.** Place your E-Z UP® frame in the center of area to be shaded. Stand in front of shelter, grasp outer legs and extend arms to partially open shelter - approximately  $\frac{1}{3}$  its total size.



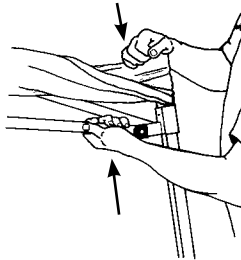
**\*2.** Gently unfold the fabric top and place it over the open frame. The front of the frame will have the large diamond truss.



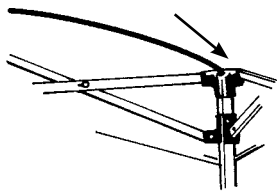
**\*3.** Attach J-hooks sewn on the top into holes located in the bottom of the legs.



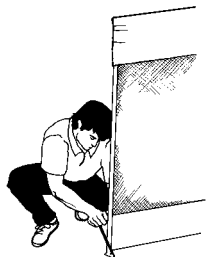
**4.** Stand in front of shelter, grasp large center diamond on upper left and lower right side and press diamond together until front auto-sliders engage snap buttons on front legs.



**5.** Walk around back of shelter and lift fabric. Engage auto-slider by pushing up on slider with one hand while pushing down on top of leg with other hand. The snap button will engage in hole. Pull out fabric.



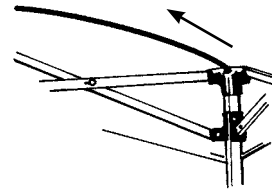
**6.** Reach under shelter and locate flex rod clipped to inside of trusses. Remove flex rod from clip. Firmly insert end of flex rod that is attached to frame in plastic corner bracket hole. Place the other end of the flex rod in the pouch on the front of the top.



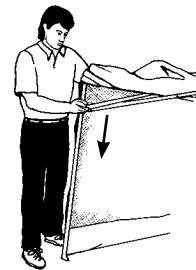
**7.** Stake down your E-Z UP® with the stakes provided. Fill sewn in pockets with sand for added stability.

**\*Note:** Once top is permanently attached only preform steps 4 - 7.

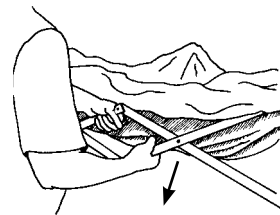
## How To Take Down



**1.** Remove end of flex rod that is attached to frame in plastic corner bracket hole and clip rod into retaining clip located on the trusses.



**2.** Release auto-slider at all three corners by slightly lifting up on slider with one hand while depressing snap button with other hand. Once snap button is depressed, push slider down past snap button.



**3.** Stand in front of shelter, grasp large center diamond on upper left and lower right side and spread diamond apart while lifting front two legs off ground. Step in to help close; fold sides of fabric into center of frame.



**4.** Grasp adjacent outer legs and push shelter together until fully closed. **Be careful not to pinch fingers!** Store E-Z UP® in cover bag.

## Important Information

**IMPORTANT!** Read this information before proceeding. It is the user's responsibility to take the following precautions at all times.

- Use caution when handling the E-Z UP® folding frame. Avoid pinching hands or fingers as frame opens or closes.
- Always stake or weight down your E-Z UP®. Do not use in any potentially windy or rainy weather. Wind and rain can damage the E-Z UP® Wedge™ and may also result in injury to you or others. Therefore, do not rely on shelter for protection in heavy or prolonged rain storms.
- Do not use shelter in a lightning storm.
- The E-Z UP® Wedge™ is designed as a temporary shelter. Do not leave up for extended periods.
- Do not leave your E-Z UP® Wedge™ unattended.
- Keep all flame and heat sources away from top fabric. Do not build fires within shelter enclosure.

## Care and Maintenance

For long lasting durability and the best possible protection for your E-Z UP® Wedge™, follow these E-Z care and maintenance instructions:

- Use a mild soap (not detergent) and plenty of water for cleaning top.
- Let the E-Z UP® top and frame dry completely before closing or storing, to avoid mildew.
- Frame will operate and look better if occasionally wiped with silicone spray, especially before and after use in damp conditions. Remove excess silicone residue before applying top.
- Slightly tighten bolts if frame becomes loose.
